MATERIAL	WHAT	HOW	NO
PLASTIC	#1 #1 #1 #2 <small>#1 & #2 plastics only are accepted by our current market</small>	Remove Caps, Empty Completely, Rinse, Drain Bottles & Jugs ONLY	#3 #4 #5 #6 #7 Wide Mouth Containers, Auto Petroleum Products, Styrofoam or Plastic Bags <u>Do Not put in plastic bags</u>
GLASS	ALL Colors Bottles, Jars, Cookware Ceramics, Pottery	Remove Caps & Covers Labels O.K. Rinse Well	Light Bulbs Window Glass Mirrors <u>Do Not put in plastic bags</u>
ALUMINUM & TIN/STEEL CANS	Drink Cans, Food Cans, Empty Paint Cans Empty Aerosol Cans Pie Plates, Clean Foil	Empty Completely Rinse clean Put Tops Inside Cans	Containers with ANY material remaining or Rusty Cans <u>Do Not put in plastic bags</u>

FIBER RECYCLABLES			
MATERIAL	WHAT	HOW	NO
CORRUGATED CARDBOARD	Clean, Dry Uncoated Cardboard & Paper Bags	Boxes must be <u>FLATTENED</u> (2' x 2' Maximum)	Coated, Waxed, Greasy or Soiled Cardboard
NEWSPAPER	Newspapers with Inserts Only	Place in <u>Separate</u> <u>PAPER BAG</u> from Mixed Paper	Do not put other Recyclable Material in the same bag
MIXED PAPER	Office Paper, Junk Mail, Magazines, Cereal Boxes, Phone Books,	Place in <u>Separate</u> <u>PAPER BAG</u> from Newspaper	Aseptic Packaging Gable Top Containers Do not put other Recyclable Material in the same bag

OTHER RECYCLABLE ITEMS			
MATERIAL	WHAT	HOW	NO
TEXTILES	Most Clothing Towels, Hats, Shoes, Sheets, Belts, Drapes, Curtains, Etc.	Put in a plastic bag and tie the top closed. <u>Please mark</u> <u>"TEXTILES"</u>	Wet or Soiled Textiles, Rugs, Yarn, String, Fabric Scraps or High Heeled Shoes
