SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY

INFORMATION SHEET

HOURS OF OPERATION:

Tuesday and Saturday - 7:30 AM - 3:15 PM

FACILITY LOCATION:

From Route 108 South, go over Oyster River Bridge and take first left onto Durham Point Road. Facility is one mile down on right hand side of road.

From Route 108 North, take right onto Durham Point Road. Facility is one mile down on right hand side of road.

OBTAINING A PERMIT:

Permits may be obtained at the Public Works Department, 100 Stone Quarry Drive, Monday through Friday, 8 AM - 12 Noon and 12:30 PM - 4:30 PM. The cost for an annual affixed permit is \$5.00. Temporary and construction permits are also available. License plate numbers must be known in order to obtain a permit.

Annual permits are to be affixed to the inside lower left corner of the windshield, driver's side.

ITEMS ACCEPTED WITH BULKY WASTE COUPONS (limit 2 trips/1 ton per household per year):

- A. DEMOLITION/CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS
- B. FURNITURE AND STUFFED GOODS
- C. ALL PAINTED OR STAINED WOOD

RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

- A. **GLASS CONTAINERS.** Clear, green or brown.
- B. **PLASTIC.** "Only plastic bottles are accepted. A bottle is defined as an item having a neck opening much less than the diameter of the base of the container." **NO WIDE MOUTH OR OIL PRODUCT CONTAINERS ARE ACCEPTED.**
PET PLASTIC (TRANSPARENT). Triangle and "1" symbol on the bottom.
HDPE PLASTIC (TRANSLUCENT). Triangle and "2" symbol on the bottom.
P.P. AND OTHER PLASTIC. Triangle and "5" or "7" symbol on the bottom.
- C. **ALUMINUM CANS**
- D. **STEEL (TIN) CANS**
- E. **NEWSPAPER.** Inserts acceptable. Must be placed in separate paper bag.
- F. **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD.** Must be broken down and flat.
- G. **MIXED OFFICE PAPER.** Includes cereal boxes, shoe boxes, magazines, telephone books and junk mail. Must be put out in a separate paper bag.
- H. **TIRES.** No rims.
- I. **METAL/SCRAP METAL.** Appliances.
- J. **TEXTILES.** Clothing, shoes, etc. placed in a plastic garbage bag and marked "TEXTILES". There is also a Goodwill Bin on-site.
- K. **AUTO BATTERIES.**
- L. **DRY CELL BATTERIES.**
- M. **OIL FILTERS.** Motor oil, diesel fuel, hydraulic oil.
- N. **WASTE OIL.** Waste motor oil. Must be clean with no additives.
- O. **OIL BASED PAINT.** In original containers (only accepted May thru September)
- P. **PROPANE TANKS.**

OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED:

BRUSH AND TREE LIMBS. Not to exceed 5 feet in length and 5 inches in diameter.

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:

The following materials will not be accepted at the SWMF.

- A. **ASBESTOS MATERIALS/PRODUCTS** (contact NHDES 271-2900).
- B. **INFECTIOUS WASTE.** Lab, pathology waste (contact NHDES 271-3503).
- C. **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** (contact NHDES 271-2900).
- D. **SEPTIC WASTE** (accepted at Wastewater Treatment Plant).
- E. **ASH RESIDUE** (Waste Management Facility in Rochester).
