**ARTICLES**

**ARTICLE 3:** Shall the District vote to approve within the provisions of New Hampshire RSA 273-A:3 the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Oyster River Educational Support Personnel Association (ORESPA ) and the Oyster River School Board which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

2010-2011	\$ 6,315
2011-2012	\$ 7,418
2012-2013	\$12,598

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$6,315 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increases in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels in accordance with the most recent collective bargaining agreement? Pursuant to RSA 273-A:12, VII, this collective bargaining agreement, including pay plan, but excluding the cost of living increases, will continue until a new agreement is executed. *The School Board recommends this appropriation. (Majority vote required)*

**ARTICLE 4:** Shall the District raise and appropriate a sum of \$253,000 for capital improvement items at all District facilities, including but not limited to heating controls, fire alarm & sprinkler systems, electrical upgrades and security cameras? *The School Board recommends this appropriation. (Majority vote required)*

**ARTICLE 5:** Shall the District raise and appropriate a sum of \$95,000 for technology improvement and upgrade items, including but not limited to replacement of the data cabling at SAU and telephone system replacement? *The School Board recommends this appropriation. (Majority vote required)*

**ARTICLE 6:** Shall the District raise and appropriate up to \$50,000 to be added to the expendable trust fund known as the Special Education Fund, with such amount to be funded from the year-end undesignated fund balance surplus? *The School Board recommends this appropriation. (Majority vote required)*

**ARTICLE 7:** Shall the District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant article and other appropriations voted separately, the amount set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$38,767,019 distributed as follows: Fund 10 = \$37,012,372 (regular operating budget); Fund 21 = \$786,343 (expenditures from food service revenues); Fund 22 = \$818,769 (expenditures form federal/special revenues); Fund 23 = \$149,535 (expenditures from pass through funds)? Should this article be defeated, the operating budget shall be \$38,474,981 (Default Budget) which is the same as last year with certain adjustments required by previous action of the district or by law; or the district may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13, X, and XVI to take up the issue of the revised operating budget only. *The School Board recommends this appropriation. (Majority vote required)*
