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SUMMER ART CAMP OFFERED AT THE MUSEUM OF ART, UNH

DURHAM, N.H. – The Museum of Art, University of New Hampshire is offering week-long summer art classes for children and teens on Monday through Friday during the weeks of August 2-6 and August 9-13, 2010. Students in grades 4 – 12 have a wide variety of classes to choose from and may sign up for classes during the morning (9 am – noon) or afternoon sessions (1 – 4 pm) or both. The cost is \$125 per session or \$225 for two sessions during the same week. At the end of each week, students are invited to share their work in a special exhibition held by the Museum of Art. Classes include the cost of basic materials. Lunch is not provided, but students are welcome to bring their lunches to enjoy in the Paul Creative Arts Center. Supervision is provided during the lunch hour. Pre-registration is required by July 16, 2010.

During the first week, Monday, August 2 – Friday, August 6, 2010, classes during the morning session (9 am – noon) for grades 4 – 6 include: *Introduction to Drawing* with instructor Gretchen Woodman; *Fun with Photography* with instructor Julie Hamel; and *Beginner Fiber Arts* with instructor Tameson O'Brien. Classes for grades 7 – 9 include: *Intermediate Painting* with instructor Judy Krassowski; and *Intermediate Watercolor* with instructor Mary Mojica. The class for grades 9-12 is *Chinese Brush Painting* with instructor Bruce Iverson. Classes during the afternoon session (1– 4 pm) for grades 4 – 6 include: *Introduction to Watercolor* with instructor Mary Mojica; and *Introduction to Painting* with instructor Judy Krassowski. For grades 7 – 9, the classes offered are *Introduction to Printmaking* with instructor Gretchen Woodman; *Intermediate Fiber Arts*

with instructor Tameson O'Brien; and *Photography* with instructor Julie Hamel. For grades 9-12 the class offered is *Advanced Drawing & Portfolio Development* with instructor Tom Hibsham.

During the second week, Monday, August 9 – Friday, August 13, 2010, the class offered during the morning session (9 am – noon) for grades 4 – 6 is *Art Box I* with instructor Kimberly Olson; for grades 7 – 9, *Wire: 3D Forms & Jewelry* with instructor Judy Krassowski; and for grades 9-12, *Photography* with instructor Julie Hamel. During the afternoon session, the class offered for grades 4- 6 is *Art Box II* with instructor Kimberly Olson; for grades 7-9, *Hand-building with Clay* with Instructor Meghan E. Samson; and the class offered for grades 9-12 is *Digital Photography* with instructor Julie Hamel.
