

**DURHAM CONSERVATION COMMISSION**  
**Minutes to Meeting**

**September 29, 2005**

Meeting called to order at 7:10 pm

This special meeting of the Durham Conservation Commission (DCC) was called for the sole purpose of discussing the merits of the DCC submitting a Pre-Proposal to the NHDES for a 2006 Watershed Assistance and Restoration Grant to address sediment erosion at Jackson's Landing. After much discussion regarding the sediment-erosion problems at Jackson's Landing, the recreational potential of the site and political implications of proceeding with submission of the proposal, the DCC voted unanimously for the following two motions:

1. The DCC has determined that it is not an appropriate time to proceed with the Jackson's Landing Pre-Proposal to meet the October 7, 2005 deadline for submission to the NHDES.

2. The DCC believes that there is an opportunity for the DCC, Park and Recreation *Committee* and other citizens to work for both erosion control and recreational uses at Jackson's Landing and requests that the DCC chair bring this suggestion to Town Council.
