Some of the ideas brought forth as future projects for the two groups to work on cooperatively included the planned survey of Durham's historical sites; ways to get younger citizens interested in the DHA; getting more presence on the town's website; increase overall interest in historic preservation; providing research and information for homeowners of historic properties; and more inclusion and work with downtown businesses, specifically with a plaquing project.

Cathy Leach updated the group on the grant proposal submitted to the NH Division of Historical Resources for the development of an educational brochure.

Crawford Mills suggested that the HDC begin to move forward with the survey project, and will have that on next month's agenda.
