- I. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m.
- II. Approval of Minutes
  - A. Minutes for February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009 approved with the addition of a period at the end of last sentence.
  - B. Minutes for March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2009 approved with the correction of the spelling of “Strawberry Banke” to “Strawbery Banke” and the change of the word “dame” to “dam.” Both corrections in 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph of New Business.
- III. New Business
  - A. Discussion of literature provided by Andrea Bodo, on the effectiveness of various river restorations nationally and locally.
  - B. Discussion of possible revisions to Historic District Overlay to strengthen architectural guidelines for new construction, and to expand the boundaries of the Historic District.
