- <u>Review UH Student and Landlord Booklet Distribution:</u> Brett Mongeon distributed cards regarding UNH students living off campus.

- <u>Trash Removal/Recycling Update:</u> Paul Berton reported a very successful trash removal pilot program at his apartment complex during the May move out process.
- <u>Spring Fling:</u>
  - Appears to be a magnet for "outsiders"; large percentage of arrestees not UNH students.
  - Do activities at Whittemore Center such as pro wrestling and monster trucks add to the academic mission of UNH, or detract?
  - What action can be taken by UNH officials to penalize those UNH students who break rules/laws? Should there be an academic penalty for "bad behavior"? (This has been discussed for several years).

- Paul Berton reported that his policy of requiring parental co-signatures on leases is proving to be very beneficial.
- Does the "3 unrelated parties" in the Zoning Ordinance affect this behavior?
