- Reassess interest periodically as conditions change, with the idea that concern about food access will increase

Strategic Planning

- Communicate the work that is already happening by the Ag Comm and others, such as Seacoast Permaculture, Seacoast Eat Local

- Create overlap between organizations to reinforce the small steps that are being taken to support local food production and share resources in the face of the overwhelming nature of climate change impacts

Incentives to hold on to/attract farmers?

Broaden the interpretation of eating locally to eating regionally
