Criteria for Food Friendly Yards:

Gardens, including "edible landscaping" for growing fruits and vegetables.

Beehives

Chickens or turkeys

Pollinator flower gardens, providing food for pollinating insects and employing no chemical pesticides harmful to pollinators.

Please display your Food Friendly Yard sign though out the growing season. Remove and save it at the end of the season for use the following year. If you should lose your sign or need a replacement you may purchase a new one for a small fee by contacting the Durham Agricultural Commission.
