Dear Gail and Todd:

Budget year 2017 has brought a few moderate changes to the overall IT budget. In a numbers of ways we've stayed consistent in funding initiatives that play the overall goals of supporting business processes throughout town operations and implementing solutions to increase staff efficiencies and reduce overall waste.

Highlights from the 2017 IT budget:

- Hardware/Software has been broken out into the 2017-2026 CIP document as recommended by the town council during last year's budget discussions. The amount budgeted for hardware/software in the 2017-2026 CIP remains consistent with what would have appeared in the 2017 IT operating budget.
- Due to some **outstanding** volunteer work, new internal processes, and lack of an appropriate external service offering to match our needs, supplemental IT support has been removed from Contracted Services line item for the budget year 2017. Should department demands change the Town Administrator will be notified immediately so that appropriate corrective actions can be taken.
- Due to the success we've had in keeping our external services running over the last year, Fiber Internet has again been included in the Web Services line item. This fiber replaced a failing Comcast business coaxial line that had been included in previous budgets.

The 2017 budget year holds with it many mounting issues, from GIS to a ground-up renovation of the Durham police station. IT continues to be an integral part of the initiatives of other town departments as we all strive to do more with less. We enter this next budget year in good condition, ready to take on the challenges that lay ahead.
