Accounts for 80% of a full-time individual to perform parking enforcement within the Town of Durham (remaining 20% is budgeted under Police for evidence work). Parking has evolved dramatically over the past several years with the addition of 26 "pay and display" klosks that accept every method of payment to include coin, paper currency, debit and credit cards. Each machine has a Wi-Fi connection to banks where the Town is credited with the funds. These are highly technical machines that require a year-round approach to maintenance, monitoring and ensuring that they are functioning properly. Such seemingly simple tasks such as replacing the paper in each machine so that the customer has a receipt to place on their vehicle dashboard requires constant attention by a trained person. Additionally we have instituted a year-round parking strategy for Depot Road, even during the summer months.

We have experienced difficulty obtaining a single person for this task, so we have hired two persons, each working 20 hours a week. They are retained to work the 37 weeks of the UNH academic year to assist in parking enforcement.

The strategy of retaining a part-time clerk has ensured that there is significant focus placed on the ticket data input, billing, collection and statistical analysis of all parking funds. This position provides 25 hours per week to focus on administrative tasks associated with parking.

As an example, during June of 2016 the 26 kiosks brought in \$19,000 but the cost for use of credit cards to the vendor and banks was \$5,400. THe higher the usage, the higher the fees.

Due to the volume of parking, monthly charges to the Town were approximately \$4,700 per month with charges to Ventek approximately \$400 per month.

The Town has completely reverted to a pay and display system by installing kiosks that credit, debit cards, paper and coins for payment. The new machines are technologically sophisticated to accept all of these payment methods and have Wi-Fi capability, money counters and other nuances that require routine maintenance. The warranty on each machine has expired resulting in extended warranties on each machine at almost \$1,000 per machine. While significant, some of the more sophisticated items on the machine would vastly cost more.

In addition, modems on the kiosks required updating in 2016 and the pay and display modules requires significant number of paper rolls so that the receipt can be displayed on the vehicle dashboard demonstrating payment. Additionally, other items include batteries, unique cleaning material and an occasional solar panel component changing.
