Re: FY2022 Proposed Parks & Recreation Budget

I am pleased to provide the proposed FY2022 Parks & Recreation Department budget for your consideration and support. Durham citizens, Town Administrator Selig, and the Town Council have offered great support for the Parks & Recreation annual budget over the past several years. This support has allowed the Department to develop and maintain a series of after school programs, add a variety of community events and enhance existing events, increase part-time staffing, offer additional adult program opportunities, and expand our summer camp offerings and the REACH partnership camp. The FY2022 Parks and Recreation proposed budget will not only allow us to continue to creativity organize and facilitate a variety of quality recreation programs for the community, but more importantly it will create a more sustainable and resilient department with the addition of a second full time recreation 'professional.

The Parks & Recreation Department FY2022 proposed budget is an overall increase of 35% from FY2021. Outlined below is the key account and details that support this increase:

• <u>Full Time Wages</u>- The addition of a second full time recreation profession will help create a more sustainable department and provided needed support for this growing department. Additional benefits of adding a second full time position include, the potential for increased program opportunities, the department to be more forward thinking with projects, events and seasonal planning. Greater attention to collaborative efforts and fundraising to help enhance our parks, recreation facilities and spaces, community events and programs.

This proposed budget will be acceptable for the Parks & Recreation Department to accomplish department goals and focus on the adopted Council goals related to this department. In 2022 we will continue to navigate the unpredictable and ongoing challenges COVID presents, while safely offering a full slate of programs and events to the community. A CIP proposal has been submitted for 2022 to enhance Woodridge Park. If this funding is approved, we plan to make several upgrades to the park including, two designated pickleball courts, a covered picnic pavilion area, additional skate park features, bike pump track, and updates to the basketball court area. Jackson's Landing will also be evaluated for possible future updates and features that allow for more inclusive play. We will continue to work closely with the rink manger to help push forward improvements and renovation efforts at Churchill Rink.

Durham Parks & Recreation recognizes the value and importance of the positive relationships and partnerships that have been built between UNH, various community organizations, town departments and ORCSD. We will continue to foster these relationships to enrich this dynamic department to provide quality programs and events for the community.

We appreciate the support our residents offer, as it aligns with our commitment to provide a wide range of quality programs, parks, and facilities that encourage community members to participate in healthy, fun, and educational activities and events. With your support, we can continue to celebrate the essential role public recreation plays in fostering a cohesive and vibrant community. The benefits of recreation are endless!
