- 1. Daily seasonal stream flow data of the Oyster River for the past 10 years
- 2. Mill Pond water quality improvement options; and
- 3. Reclassification of the dam from "Low Hazard" to "Non-Menace"

The Board believes Durham's historic dam landscape is at stake, and is worth further analysis of the Oyster River watershed and various solutions for the dam and Mill Pond.
