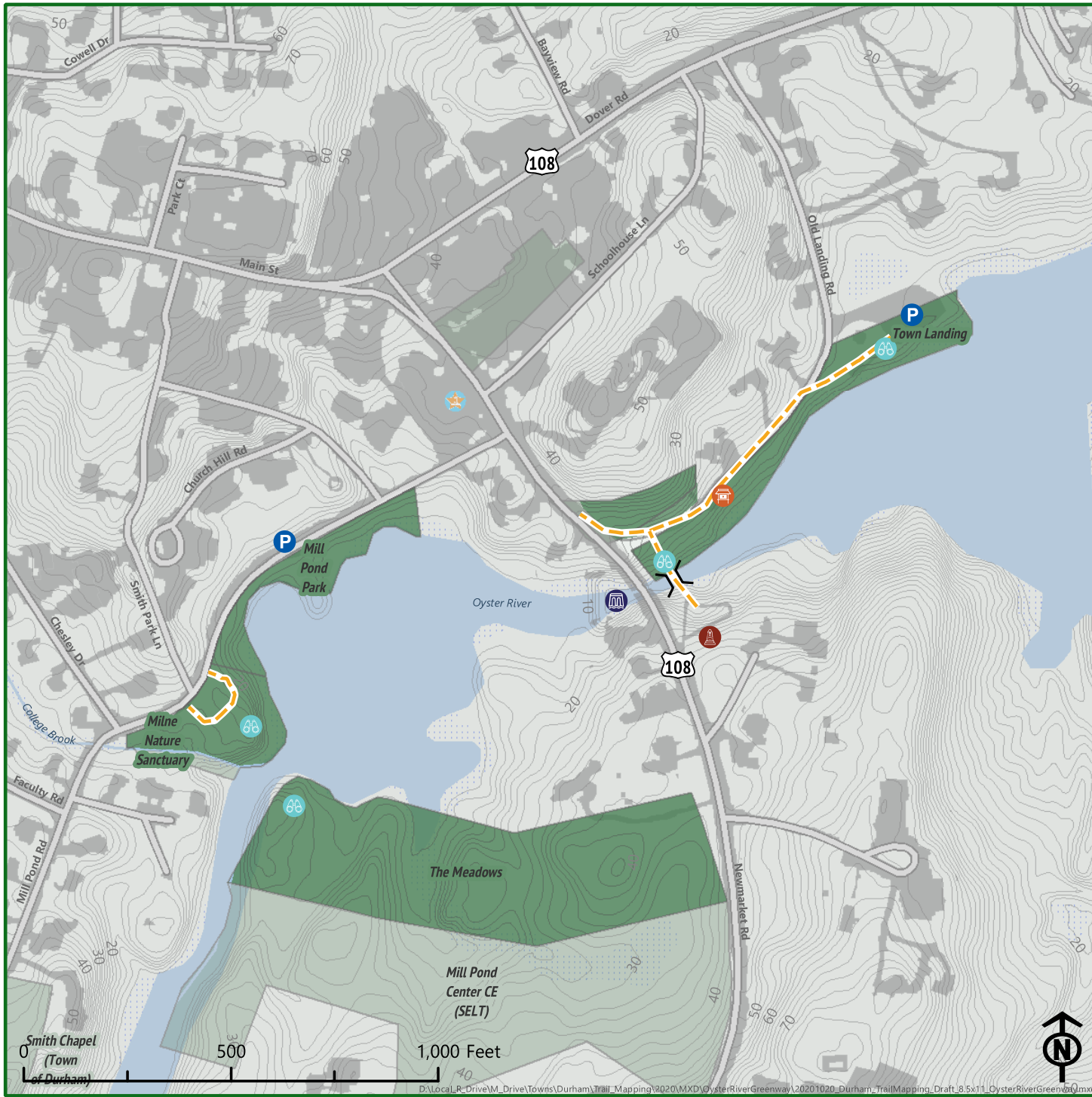


Milne Nature Sanctuary

Easement or Deed Restriction	<p>Deed contains the following use restriction pertaining to this land: “...to use, maintain, and administer...as a wildlife sanctuary for the preservation of wild plants and native animals, a source of serenity and a place to observe undisturbed nature—not as a playground—to be known as “The Valley Nature Area—the Gift of Dr. Lorus J. Milne and Dr. Margery J. Milne.”</p> <p>Grantor also provided a \$25,000 endowment to maintain the area and establish a stone memorial monument, and to create a wildflower garden around the monument.</p>
