The Conservation Commission had a site walk at the Oyster River High School athletic fields. The purpose of the site walk was to gather information to help us in considering a wetlands permit being submitted to DES as a part of the construction of a track and artificial turf field. Questions were asked about the drainage from the turf field, and the velocity and volume of water at the point of discharge into the remaining wetlands. The drain will have a lip on it the will hold back water and decrease the amount of the discharge from the field. We also discussed the number of trees to be cut, and encouraged them to try and hold the number to a minimum.
