The Subcommittee's task is to develop proposed changes to the Wetland Conservation Overlay District (WCOD) and Shoreland Protection Overlay District (SPOD) in the Durham Zoning Ordinance and to present its proposal to the Conservation Commission for consideration. Any proposed zoning changes will be presented to the Planning Board which will hold a public hearing if the Board considers initiating the amendments. Zoning changes are adopted by the Town Council at its discretion following a public hearing.
