## **Star-gazing Snowshoe Hike at Thompson Forest: March 11th 7:30pm**

Meet at Thompson Forest (off from Wednesday Hill Rd.) for a guided hike, including star-gazing with the NH Astronomical Association.

## **Old Landing Park to Milne Sanctuary Walk-Talk: March 18th 10am-12pm**

Meet at the covered picnic area at Old Landing Park for a guided walk-talk on the history of Old Landing Park, Mill Pond and Milne Sanctuary. Optional Lunch Meet-Up concluding the walk at Young's Restaurant at 12noon.

## **Salamander Migration- Sweet Trail: April 18th 10am-12pm**

Meet at the parking lot off from Dame Rd. From there we will explore the vernal ponds off the Sweet Trail for Salamanders and other local habitat.
