June 27, 1989 Public Hearing was held at 7:30 pm at the Oyster River High School

July 18, 1989 Durham Special Election held to vote on the following:

Are you in favor of the adoption of this article to raise and appropriate the sum of Three Million One Hundred Thousand (\$3,100,000) Dollars for the purpose of acquiring the land and buildings of the Wagon Hill Farm on Route 4 in Durham in order to preserve its scenic vistas, provide for future municipal purposes and preserve open space in order to provide for healthful and attractive outdoor environment for work and recreation and to conserve land, water, forest, and wildlife resources; such sum to be raised by the issuance if serial bonds or notes not to exceed Three Million One Hundred Thousand (\$3,100,000) Dollars under and in compliance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (N.H. R.S.A. 33:1 et seq., as amended) and to authorize the Durham Town Council to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon; to invest the proceeds and to expend the earnings of the proceeds on the project; to apply for and accept other funds; and to take such other actions as may be necessary to effect the issuance, negotiation, sale, and delivery of such bonds or notes as shall be in the best interests of the Town of Durham.

No property acquired by these funds on the south side of Route 4 shall be sold without a vote of the citizens of the Town.
