KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Alice H. O. van da Linda, now of Lausanne, Switzerland

for consideration paid, grant to Town of Durham

with Quitclaim Covenants

All of my right title and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land containing one-eighth (1/8) of an acre, more or less, situated in said Durham bounded and described as follows:

Bounded on the east and northeast sides by the highway leading from Dover to Newmarket; on the southwest and west sides by Oyster River; on the north by land formerly occupied by Harry Willey, together with all my right in the water fall, mill dam, mill yard, water privileges and rights of flowage which I have in and to the mill privilege on or adjoining the above described property.

Meaning and intending to convey the premises conveyed to Edith A. Onderdonk, and inherited by me from her, by deed of Samuel Runlet dated November 26, 1912 recorded in the Strafford County Registry of Deeds, Book 366, Page 146, by deed of Joshua Pinkham, et als dated 1913 and recorded in the Strafford County Registry of Deeds, Book 386, Page 415 and by deed of Fred E. Jenkins dated May 19, 1913 recorded in the Strafford County Registry of Deeds, Book 369, Page 269.

Subject, however, to the terms, conditions and reservations contained in said deeds.

Consideration less than \$100; no revenue stamps necessary.

And I, Lloyd van da Linda, husband of said grantor, release to said grantee all rights of curtesy dower and homestead and other interests therein.
