Chair Stanhope:

Please find attached our application to the HDC on behalf of the Three Chimneys Inn for two landscape improvement projects to be completed this Spring and Fall.

Karen Meyer, Innkeeper at the Three Chimneys Inn, has hired Woodburn & Company to provide suggestions for landscape maintenance and improvements to upgrade the overall appearance of the landscape at the inn. We are currently in the process of developing a long term landscape master plan that focuses on landscape elements that need attention, maintenance and renovation in order to enhance the historic character of the inn and showcase the property to prospective visitors.

The first two projects planned for installation will upgrade the area around the sign and driveway. Visitors to Durham don't always know where the inn is and miss seeing the existing sign. We've suggested that the tumbled down stones surrounding the sign be reset as a low retaining wall, that the sign be set plumb. The existing plantings will be renovated in a tiered combination of flowering shrubs and perennials. See attached before photos and after sketch.

In addition to the work around the sign, the existing stone retaining wall running along the north side of the driveway will be rebuilt using the existing stone and augmenting it with larger aged granite pieces. The result will be a renovated stone wall, roughly the same height as the existing with tighter joints and a look more in keeping with the existing walls along Newmarket Road and adjacent to the existing carriage house. 
