**Call to Order.** Sally called the meeting to order at 10:05 am. Al Howland gave an update to various housing initiatives in Concord.

<u>Proposed Zoning Amendments – Public Presentation and Discussion</u>. Sally gave a powerpoint explaining the zoning amendments developed by the Housing Task Force. These involve changes to the Table of Uses, Table of Dimensions, and text of the ordinance. The purpose is to expand housing opportunities in Durham.

The amendments will be presented to the Planning Board for formal consideration in the coming months as the board's schedule permits. Carden Welsh asked several questions. Then Ken Holmes spoke about the relationship between UNH and the town regarding housing. He said that UNH can now house 6400 students on campus. Their consultant has suggested reducing that capacity to 5,500 students. The goal of UNH is to house 50% of their students on campus. They are close to that now.
