"Stewarding Our Lands" LSS Working Group 1/17/23 meeting summary

In attendance: Sally Needell, Gale Carey, Ann Welsh, Sara Callaghan, Mike Drooker (Zoom)

- 1) We reviewed the first draft of the **Oyster River Forest/Spruce Hole Bog (ORF/SHB)**Questionnaire findings. Key items discussed were:
 - a. More clearly define parking orientation and spaces at both parking areas.
 - b. Use trail counters to collect user information.
 - c. Redo kiosk signage to clarify why hunting is allowed on this property.
 - d. Add signage regarding "fragile ecosystem" and that dogs must be leashed on all paths at Spruce Hole Bog.
 - e. Consider adding an Observation platform at SHB with educational signage.
 - f. Consider adding dog poop bags to kiosk areas
 - g. Consider adding a bench near the SHB connector.
- 2) We discussed ways to present the findings from the **Wagon Hill** Questionnaire to the LSC. In light of the stated purpose of Wagon Hill Farm, we distilled the Working Group's recommendations into 3 areas: (1) <u>parking</u> given the house renovations, is more parking needed? Or given that the property is being "loved to death", should parking remain as it? Less? (2) <u>dogs</u> would a spacially separate area for dogs ease the dogs-no dogs tension so apparent in the questionnaire comments? (3) <u>wildlife</u> would fencing be useful to protect wildlife and sensitive areas such as bobolink nesting and waterfront?
- 3) Additional items: Sara created a sign with a QR code that links to the **Longmarsh** questionnaire, so anyone using the property can participate in the questionnaire. We discussed the value at some future date, perhaps 2024 of having QR codes on each property that allows users to quickly and easily report an issue/concern.

Action Items:

- 1) Gale will contact Rich Reine for advice on ways to delineate the parking orientation and spaces at the **ORF/SHB** parking areas.
- 2) Sara will become familiar with the trail counters, then install 2 at the **ORF/SHB** to give us more information about usage of that property (one near Packers Falls parking area, one near stone wall where Oyster River Forest meets College Woods).
- 3) Sara and Gale will walk the **ORF/SHB** with a critical eye on ways to improve the trail signs there (per questionnaire comments).
- 4) Gale will revise the recommendations on draft #2 **ORF/SHB** questionnaire findings.
- 5) Sara will install posts with QR code at two sites on **Longmarsh** inviting visitors to access the Longmarsh Questionnaire.
- **6)** Gale will present the questionnaire findings from **Wagon Hill** to the LSC at the Jan 24 meeting.
