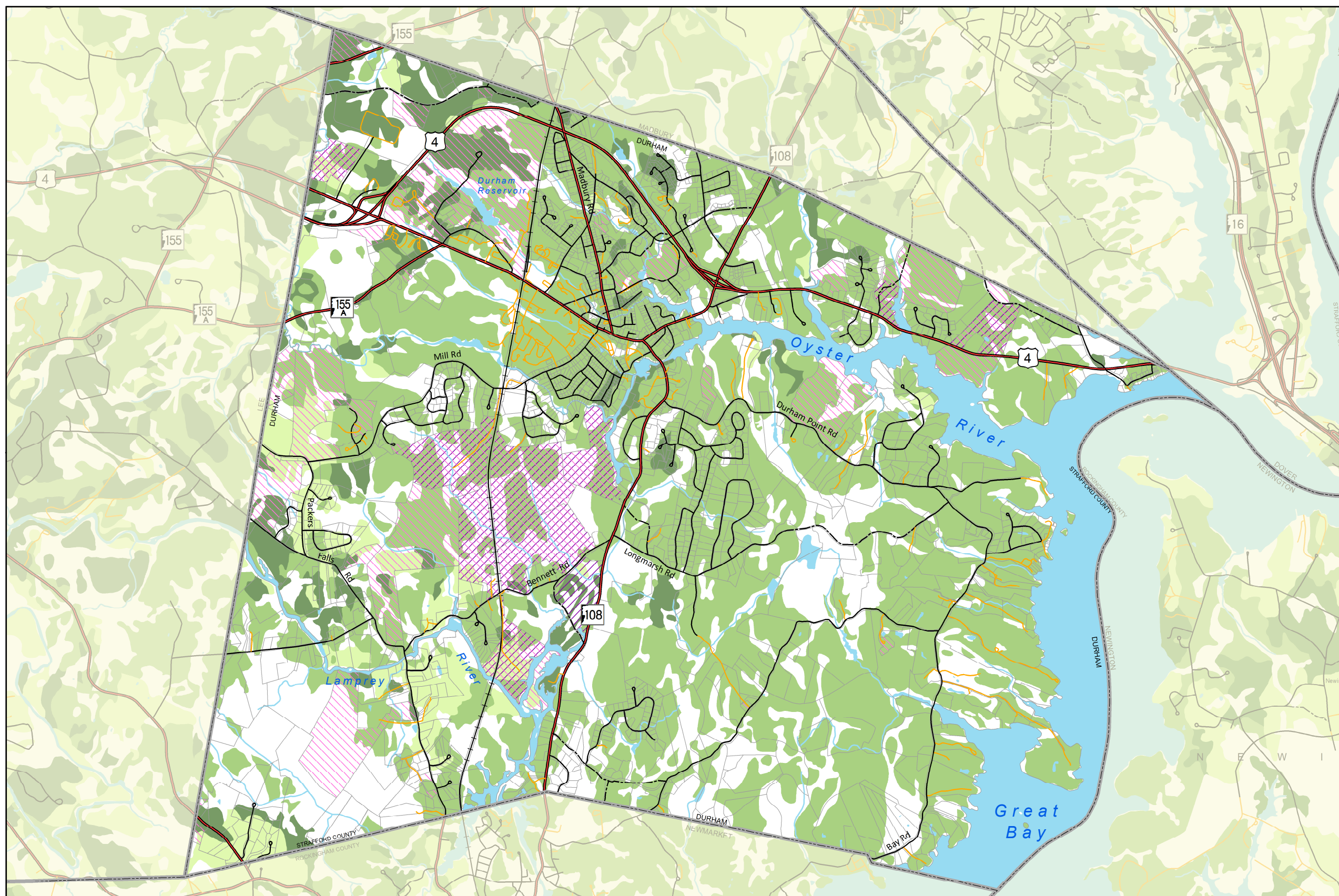
Forest Resources

Note: Intent to Cut and Recently Harvested data does not mean that the entire parcel was cut/harvested.

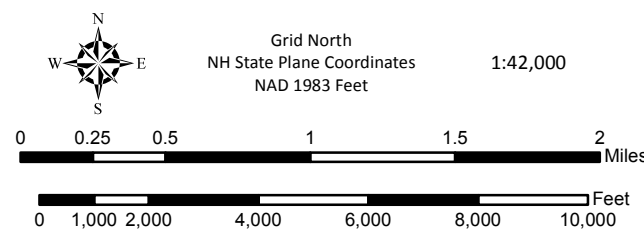
