I. Call to Order

II. Roll Call and Seating of Alternates

Due to exigencies of the coronavirus we can have a maximum of 5 people at the front table – the staff plus four board members. The other board members communicated via teleconference. III.

IV. Town Planner's Report

Per order of the governor we can have a maximum of ten people in the room. Residents are encouraged to call in to the meeting or send comments in advance.

- VI. **Public Comments.** There were none.
- VIII. <u>Dover Road Lot Line Adjustment</u>. Lot line adjustment at 88 Dover Road to expand the lot with Yates Electric . Map 11, Lot 4-2 and Map 11, Lot 3-2.

The application was accepted as complete and the public hearing was set for April 15.

IX. *Public Hearing* - <u>253 Durham Point Road – Solar Array</u>. Conditional use for freestanding solar array serving a single family house located in the Wetland Conservation Overlay District.

The public hearing was postponed to April 29. A site walk was held earlier in the day.

X. *Public Hearing* - <u>Historic District Amendments</u>. Proposed amendments to Article XVII. Historic District of the Zoning Ordinance pertaining to purview and procedures of the HDC.

The Planning Board voted to initiate the amendments as written. There were no public comments.

XI. <u>**74 Main Street – Mixed-Use Building**</u>. Design review site plan application for new 31,000 square foot five-story mixed use building . Douglas Clark, applicant. Map 2, Lot 14-1.

There was extensive discussion. The public hearing was scheduled for April 29. A site walk was scheduled for 3:00 pm on April 29.

XII. Presentation on Stormwater Management. April Talon, Durham Town Engineer.

April Talon gave the presentation. She is available to the board if questions arise in the future.

XIII. Zoning Amendments related to Agriculture. Extensive amendments to the Zoning Ordinance relating to agriculture proposed by the Durham Agricultural Commission.

The board went through the Town Planner's review of March 25 up to the middle of page 3. The review was continued to April 29.

 - <u>Mill Plaza drainage plan</u>. Consideration of recommendation from Town Engineer to hire a third party to review stormwater management plan for Mill Plaza project

The board voted to hire Horsley Witten to do an independent review of the drainage report. Tasks 1-3 at a cost of \$4,750 to be paid by the applicant.
