I. Call to Order

VIII. <u>Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity – Amendment to Plans</u>. 18 Garrison Avenue. Amendment for proposed changes to approved site plan and approved conditional uses establish a fraternity, exceed 30 feet in height, and place structures in the wetland buffer. Proposed changes include demolition of the former Elizabeth DeMeritt House, change in design for the new building, and various site changes. Richmond Property Group, c/o Sarah Layton, owner. Bruce Scamman, Emanuel Engineering. Isaac Schlosser, Krittenbrink Architecture. Map 2, Lot 12-12. Central Business District.
