- VIII. **Public Hearing Housing Amendments**. Consideration of numerous amendments to the Zoning Ordinance proposed by the Durham Housing Task Force to enhance housing opportunities in Durham.

There were numerous comments, mostly expressing significant concern about the proposal. There were several comments generally in support, at least of enhancing housing in some manner. The public hearing is continued to December 14. It is unclear how the Planning Board will proceed.
