NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Durham, NH Planning Board will hold hearings on two proposed amendments to the Zoning Ordinance as follows.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

<u>Workforce Housing</u>. The amendment would add a definition, add standards, permit workforce housing in four Research-Industry zones, make other related changes, and rezone one lot from Residence Coastal to Office Research (59 Piscataqua Road, Map 209, Lot 39, owned by Keefe Trust)

<u>Posting and Mailing of Public Notices</u>. The amendment would change the process for noticing public hearings for zoning amendments, conditional uses, historic district reviews, and UNH projects from publishing notices in a local newspaper to posting notices on the Town's website. Notices for conditional use hearings would be sent by verified mail rather than by certified mail.
