- VIII. <u>The Cottages of Durham modification</u>. Request to remove boardwalk. CDC New Hampshire, LLC, c/o Alex Freeman, property owner. Map 203, Lot 7. ORLI District.

Continued to July 9 or July 23 meeting. The board requested that a plan for removal of the boardwalk be submitted.

IX. <u>Review of Prior Year and Priorities for Upcoming Year.</u>

Plans made for consideration of several zoning and site plan regulation initiatives: Conservation Subdivisions, Wetland and Shoreland Overlay District, Electric Vehicle Charging Stations, Numerous Housing proposals, and the Planned Unit Development.

X. <u>Lodging House – Zoning Ordinance</u>. *The public hearing is closed*. Proposed change adding Lodging House as a new use and eliminating Student Rental as a use.

The board made a few minor changes to the draft and initiated the proposal as a formal zoning amendment. It will now be forwarded to the Town Council for consideration. The use would be allowed only in the Professional Office, Church Hill, and Courthouse districts.

XI. <u>Conservation Subdivision – Zoning Ordinance</u>. Continued discussion about prospective changes to Article XIX - Conservation Subdivisions.

The board started discussing proposed changes. The review is continued to July 9.
