## WEST WALL LANDSCAPE BUFFER DESCRIPTION:

At the bottom of the wall we are proposing to transplant 5 Hemlock's. 2 to the South, and 3 to the North. These will grow well under the shade of the existing trees.

Norway Spruce and Pin Oak will be planted in front of the Hemlock along the exposed portion of the wall. These two trees are fast growing trees that will grow quite large. The Norway Spruce will grow between 70 to 80', and the Pin Oak will grow between 60 and 70'.

White Pine has been eliminated as there was some concern that John Parry expressed about the White Pine Weevil pest.

Baltic English Ivy will be planted on top of the wall in front of the fence. This evergreen vine should climb the fence to provide additional visual screening. It can grow horizontally as a groundcover, or up as a climbing vine.

2 White Spruce and 1 Red Maple have been planted in front of the building closest to the wall. White Spruce will grow between 40 and 60', and the Red Maple will grow between 40 and 60'.

5 Green Giant Arborvitae will be planted in a row between the Volleyball and Wiffle Ball area to provide an additional visual buffer. These plants will grow 30' high and 15' wide. They have a soft feathery foliage which is appropriate for this active play area.

2 additional Green Giant Arborvitae will also be planted on the West wall side of the building to the South.

The Hemlocks were required to be certified pest free by the landscape contractor. These trees should be inspected periodically for signs of the Woolly Adelgid pest and sprayed if necessary.

## MAST ROAD LANDSCAPE BUFFER:

This buffer has been diversified, and designed to be more natural looking. The plants include 4 Austrian Pine, 4 White Spruce, 10 Red Stem Dogwood, and 5 Rhododendrons. The Austrian Pine and White Spruce will grow between 40 and 60'. The Red Stem Dogwood and Rhododendron will grow 8' tall and wide. They are all very hardy and tolerant of roadside conditions.
