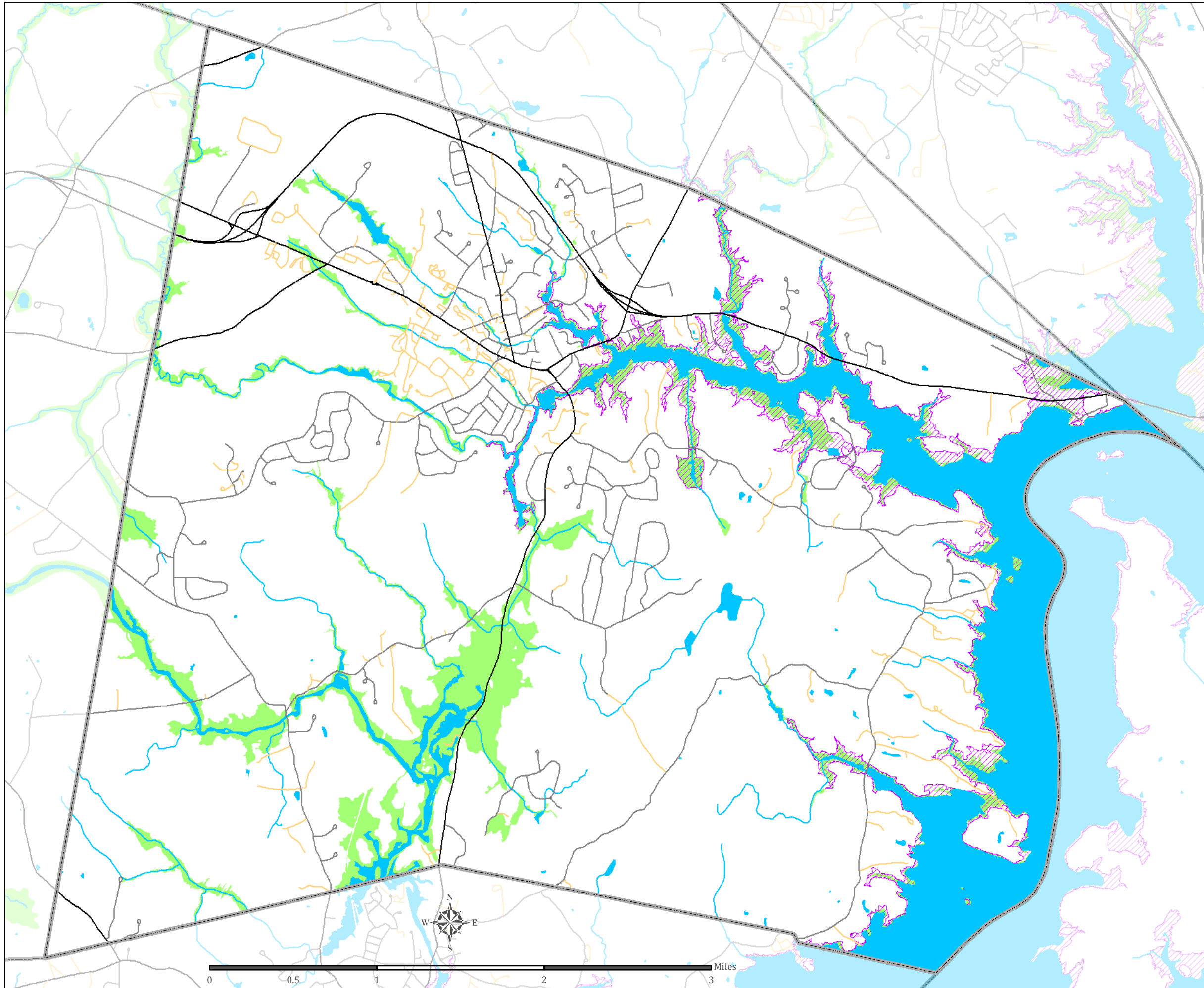


High Sea-Level Rise w. Storm Surge Scenario & FEMA Floodplain
