I have heard some of the Board's discussion, re: solar arrays and farming. Solar arrays are very often compatible with agriculture, particularly with grazing animals. And till agriculture can often be worked in, depending on the actual placement of the solar collectors. One sees many such combinations across Vermont, among other places. And Councilor Tobias is correct that solar energy can provide an important extra source of income to a farmer from having or hosting such solar arrays.
