Dear Members of the Durham Planning Board,

Now two weeks after my last letter to the Planning Board about parking in the residential zones, and several conversations with Faculty Neighborhood residents later, I would like to propose that we return to the no more than 3 cars per household regulation that previously existed before it got inadvertently moved out of our Zoning Ordinance. This was a number that people were content with and it seemed to work for most residents.

Additionally, I would like to add that any resident with more than 3 vehicles registered in the family name would be able to go to the Town Hall with his or her registration to obtain a free permit one or more vehicles. These permits would have the vehicle license plate number written on them so each would be specific to one vehicle.

Finally, we should also make clear in our ZO that there shall be no renting of parking spaces in the residential neighborhoods.

Thank you for your consideration of this issue which will impact many residents living in town.
