Hello Chiefs,

Brendan O'Sullivan (who is now the DFD Fire Marshal) approached me today about a development going in off of the Gerrish Drive/Ambler Way neighborhood. It will be a private loop that will continue out from where Gerrish Drive turns into Ambler way, down an existing driveway, and form a loop with like 10 houses on it. They are currently working with E911 to ensure addressing consistency and their current plan is to maintain this new section of road as a continuation of Gerrish Drive, which makes sense to me.

All of the houses are located in Durham, as are the driveways, but there is a short section of the road that briefly crosses into Madbury so Brendan and E911 wanted to make sure Madbury had the opportunity to weigh in on the road name.

The whole email chain and a picture of the development is at the bottom of this email. If you have any concerns, let me know and I
