The Planning Board discussed the conditional use for the proposed parking lot expansion at 19 Main Street on Wednesday. <u>The board</u> <u>requested that I ask you about one of the conditional use criteria</u> <u>related to this project. Could you get back to me by around</u> <u>Thursday, March 4?</u>

Criterion 8. <u>Fiscal impacts</u>: The proposed use will not have a negative fiscal impact on the Town unless the Planning Board determines that there are other positive community impacts that off-set the negative fiscal aspects of the proposed use. The Planning Board's decision shall be based upon an analysis of the fiscal impact of the project on the town. The Planning Board may commission, at the applicant's expense, an independent

analysis of the fiscal impact of the project on the town.

Can you give us a sense of the likely impact upon the Fire Department for the expansion of this parking lot? How much calls for service do you think this expansion would likely generate?
