
## **Inspection Findings and Recommendations:**

- 1) There was damage to the right abutment from the past two flood events. Soil had settled and eroded from the right earthen embankment adjacent to the concrete/stone training wall. The old mill foundation had suffered extensive damage from the floods. Some repairs have been made by the property owner on the right bank.
- 2) There was an active leak noted from a construction joint on the fishway that forms the left spillway training wall.
- 3) Deteriorated concrete was noted in the following locations (refer to enclosed sketch):
  - On the gate house structure/spillway training wall. An eroded section of the right concrete spillway training wall measured 6" deep.
  - The upper and lower portions of the eight concrete piers supporting the spillway slab. Along the base of the left abutment wall of the gate structure/right spillway training wall. Rebar was also exposed in this area.
  - To the right of the low level gate at the base of the downstream face.
  - On the interior ceiling of bay 6 (counting from right end). Rebar was also exposed.
  - There was concrete cracking in the support wall of Bay 4 & 5 (Refer to attached photo).
- 4) There was active leakage noted in Bay 1 along the ceiling at the spillway slab and spillway training wall junction. Leakage was also noted at the upstream toe of the right spillway training wall inside Bay 1 (refer to photos).
- 5) The dam cannot pass the routed design storm with one foot of freeboard remaining on the dam.
- 6) The emergency action plan needs updating and testing. The last test was completed in 2003 but did not move through the flowchart correctly. (Refer to enclosed for some edits.)








