Dear Mr. Selig,

I am pleased to send this correspondence to officially acknowledge that the New Hampshire Scenic & Cultural Byways Council (the Council) voted to designate the Mills Scenic Byway, as nominated by your Town. For your records, the action was taken by the Council at their May 10, 2014 meeting in Concord. The Mills Scenic Byway now joins the 17 other state & federally designated scenic and cultural byways in the State of New Hampshire.

You may have also recently been contacted by the Strafford Regional Planning Commission (SRPC), the designated Regional Planning Commission for your community. SRPC is available to assist with the next steps in the process for the Mills Scenic Byway – the creation of a Corridor Advisory Committee for the Byway, and the development of the required Corridor Management Plan. Both of these requirements are relatively new, but both I and the staff at the SRPC are available to assist you with moving forward.
