The Property was conserved in order to expand an existing block of conservation land and link it to a 563-acre privately protected forest property owned by SELT. Acquisition of the Property limits future development, preserves wetland resources, and protects habitat for wetland and other migratory birds.

SELT hereby agrees to be bound by the terms of the Grant Agreement as they relate to the Property, including the obligation to ensure the long term conservation of the Property and to obtain the consent of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service DBHC prior to the conveyance or encumbrance of any interest therein.

The terms of this Notice shall be binding upon SELT and its successors in title, designees, and assigns.
