On behalf of Eversource, I want to recognize the substantial time and effort invested by Durham town officials and residents throughout the planning and siting process for the Seacoast Reliability Project. This engagement resulted in many valuable improvements and led to the development of robust guidelines for the construction of the project.

On January 31, 2019, the New Hampshire Site Evaluation Committee issued its order affirming its unanimous approval of the Project, incorporating all of those improvements and allowing Eversource to address a critical electric reliability need in the Seacoast region.
