This letter confirms the intent of The University of New Hampshire and the Town of Durham to enter into good faith negotiations leading to renewal of the current Municipal Services Agreement which expires on December 31, 2018.

The University of New Hampshire and The Town of Durham ("The Parties") agree that over the coming months discussions will commence regarding transportation systems and policing services. Certain of these services are provided by the Town and paid for by the University under the current agreement. The Parties acknowledge:

- it is important to evaluate these functions as comprehensive services or systems,
- both the costs imposed upon and the benefits accruing to the community as a result of the University being located in Durham should be recognized,
- the basis for any compensation to the Town provided by the University should be transparent to all concerned, and
- it is the mutual goal of the Parties to have terms and conditions of the renewed agreement settled prior to expiration of the existing agreement.
