NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

At its meeting on **Monday, December 5, 2022 at 7:00 PM**

1. The Durham Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on a Resolution authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of a grant from the Community Oriented Policing Services Office of the US Department of Justice under the FY 2022 COPS Technology and Equipment Program Invitational Solicitation in an amount up to \$900,000 to replace the Town of Durham's existing Public Safety and Emergency Services Land Mobile Radio (LMR) Communications Equipment with New Modern IP Based Technology and Equipment and authorizing the Administrator to sign and submit all necessary paperwork on behalf of the Town of Durham.
2. The Durham Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Ordinance #2022-02 to Amend Chapter 153 "Vehicles and Traffic, Section 153-49 of the Durham Town Code by prohibiting parking on Madbury Road - Main Street to Garrison Avenue and Woodman Road to Garrison Avenue Extension between the hours of 1:00 am to 6:00 am, and Deleting Municipal Parking Lot Town Hall, 15 Newmarket Road.
3. The Durham Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on Ordinance #2202-03 to Amend Chapter 153 "Vehicles and Traffic, Section 153-49 of the Durham Town Code by prohibiting parking on Park Court between the hours of 1:00 am to 6:00 am.

The Town Council will be meeting in Council chambers. Members of the public may participate via Zoom teleconferencing or in-person. Participants desiring to attend via Zoom must pre-register for the meeting and may do so by going to the Town of Durham website, www.ci.durham.nh.us. On the homepage at the left is a box with "Latest News". Under that box, click on "Zoom Video Conference Meetings"; then click on the Town Council meeting link to pre-register.
